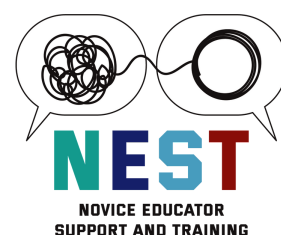

The aim of this Work Package (WP) is to establish and put into practice a consistent approach to the experimentation. WP5 provides partners with a structured framework to carry out the field trials and test the hypotheses in practice.

- **Systematic overview of mentoring structures and contextualisation of the adaptive mentoring approach:** Description of mentoring approaches for novice teachers and current mentoring practices. Available on the NEST website from: November 2021.
